LAMDA TUITION

LAMDA Acting tuition is offered at St Chris for individuals or pairs on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday on a peripatetic basis. St Chris is an accredited LAMDA examination centre.

The duration of each session is between 20 and 35 minutes depending on level and grouping. Lessons take place in the Theatre Quiet Room during timetabled lessons in much the same way as peripatetic music lessons. Lessons are scheduled on a rotational basis so the same curriculum lesson will not be missed each week. LAMDA examinations are sat during the summer term.

Lesson fees are as follows:

Individual lesson, 20 minutes or 35 minutes - £15.00/£23.50

Paired lesson, 35 minutes - £15.00 each.

The lessons will be taught by Dick Jones and Sue Scott Davison.

Dick Jones was Drama-trained at Goldsmiths' College, London University and Bulmershe College, Reading University and has a BEd (Hons). From 1975 to 1992 he was Director of Performing Arts at Frensham Heights School and from 1992 to 2005 he was Head of Drama at St Christopher School. Post-retirement, Dick is currently teaching part-time within the St Chris Drama Department. Dick is a published poet and verse translator with an interest in poetry delivered live.

Sue Scott Davison studied acting and musical theatre at Guildford School of Acting and following 25 years as a professional actor moved into theatre production in 2005. She has produced in the West End, at Shakespeare's Globe, toured nationally and co-produced the Olivier award winning, *The Railway Children* at Waterloo and Kings Cross Stations. Sue was Creative Programmer for the new Broadway Theatre in Letchworth from 2015-2018 and has taught LAMDA at Box Of Frogs Theatre Academy since 2015.
